

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A LODGING TAX

The Council of the City of Harmony does ordain:

Sec. 1 Imposition of Tax.

Each hotel, motel, rooming house, tourist court, resort, and municipal campground shall pay to the City of Harmony a lodging tax of three percent on the gross receipt from the furnishing for consideration of lodging. Said tax shall not apply to the renting or leasing of lodging for a continuous period of 30 days or more.

Sec. 2 Payment of Tax.

The hotel, motel, rooming house, tourist court, resort, or municipal campground shall report its monthly gross receipts on forms provided by the City of Harmony and shall pay any tax due by the 15th day of the following month.

Sec. 3 Disposition of Proceeds.

The gross proceeds received from the tax imposed by Section 1 shall be used to fund local convention or tourism bureaus for the purpose of marketing and promoting the City of Harmony as a tourist or convention center.

Sec. 4 Effective Date.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be December 1, 1990.
