

Ordinance No. 146

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE SALARY FOR MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF HARMONY.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 415.11 authorizes the City Council to increase the salaries of the mayor and council members by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Harmony deems the present salary of the mayor and council members inadequate to compensate them for the work incident to these offices and to attract qualified candidates to run for such offices;

THEREFORE, The Council of the City of Harmony, Fillmore County Minnesota ordains:

Sec. 1 Commencing after the general election of November 7 2000, the salary of the mayor is fixed at \$1,600.00 per year, and the salary of each council member is fixed at \$1,300.00 per year.

Sec. 2 This ordinance is effective from and after its passage and publication.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced and moved for adoption by Council Member Shuck and seconded by Council Member McKay.
