Christmas Tree Pick-up:

The Conservation Club will be picking up unwanted Christmas trees on January 3rd, 2026. Please remove all ornaments and tinsel and have your tree on the curb before 1pm.

Fats, Oils, and Grease: FOG originates from meat fats used in cooking, food scraps, cooking oil, shortening, lard, butter, margarine, gravy, and various food products. This is a reminder to **NEVER** pour FOG down the drain. It causes blockages in the sewer system and can cause raw sewage to overflow into homes.

Richard's Sanitation: The 2026 trash and recycling pick-up schedule is enclosed.

Golf Carts/UTVs/ATVs: An ordinance requires all golf carts, UTVs and ATV's to obtain a permit when driven on any public street. Also, no person under the age of (16) can drive a golf cart, UTV, or ATV unless they are accompanied by an adult. The permits can be obtained at the city office and are now \$10/year until April 30th. After May 1st the price will increase to \$12/year.

Animal License: Please stop at the City Office to renew your animal/pet license(s).



The license fee is \$15/year. On May 1st the price will increase to \$20/year. A certificate of vaccination must be provided to obtain a pet license, which is required by the city ordinance for animals over the age of 6 months. Vaccination proof must be within the last 3 years. Failure to obtain a license(s) is subject to a citation. Please be aware that a residence can only have 3 or fewer animals according to ordinance 91.06 (B). (Chickens approved with a CUP are exempt)
